

- · Portland is still a special place to live



- Drug addiction and mental health treatment should remain voluntary. No one should be required to seek or accept help.



- County commissioners should only fund shelters and programs that are open to everyone, even those actively using drugs and alcohol











- We should repeal the tax it's just not working.






State Legislature Plan for Homeless

- These are terrible ideas that will only make the problem worse







- Reforming the criminal justice system with fewer prosecutions and less jail time for both violent crimes and property crimes.




